

MINUTES
REGULAR BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING
January 11, 2010

The Bloom Township High School District 206 Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, January 11, 2010 in the boardroom of the Administration Center. Mr. Larry Nardoni called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m. The pledge of allegiance was recited.

Roll Call

Board members present were Mr. Larry Nardoni, Mrs. Donahue, Ms. Goncher, Mr. Drake, Mr. Murphy, Mr. Charles Nardoni, and Mr. Rossi. Mr. Drake moved and Ms. Goncher seconded approving the minutes of the regular meeting December 14, 2009. Upon roll call, all Board members voted "Aye." Motion carried 7-0.
